For some time, we received a number of complaints from Zone 9 Bowlers from Clubs of all sizes that the biggest demoralising factor is the lack of activity, observation and apparent favouritism shown by Selectors.

This feedback includes concerns such that certain people are chosen in grades or positions they aren't considered by their peers to be experienced enough in; or that some positions are filled by "friends" of one or more Selectors; or that none of the Selectors have spent enough time observing the standard of bowlers.

To ensure that the standard of selections is brought up to date and that the latest techniques are consistent across all Clubs, we have asked the Zone 9 Executive for permission to organise and run the **Selectors Module** which is part of the BA Coaching qualifications.
